**WOBURN SAFARI PARK VISIT - TUESDAY 10<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2018**

On Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2018, as part of our Science topic "Animals including Humans", the children in Year 3 will be visiting Woburn Safari Park. We will be going through the animal enclosure to see how animals move and behave in their environment. We will also have an educational session to look at fur, feathers, scales and skin. During the visit the children will need to observe the different types of food the animals eat as part of the healthy eating element of our topic.

In order to be able to run the trip, we are asking for a contribution of **£16.00\*** which includes coach, entrance fee and educational session.

You may pay for this trip on-line through your Joinos account. If you have not activated your account for some reason and require another Joinos code, please contact the School Office.

\*If your child is in receipt of a Free School Meal, or has been at any time in the past six years, then the cost of this particular trip will be met through our Pupil Premium funding. Please note that this is now subject to meeting our attendance criteria.

*\*If your child is not currently on our Free School Meal list, but you think might be eligible (and therefore also eligible for Pupil Premium funding), please log onto the County Council website at [www.northamptonshire.gov.uk](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk) and follow the links to Education and Learning / Information for Parents – where you will find an on-line application form together with all the information you need. Alternatively, come into school and have a chat with the staff in the school office.*

The children should wear normal school uniform, with suitable walking shoes. **A packed lunch in a disposable bag (no fizzy, canned or glass bottled drinks, please) will be needed, even if your child has a school lunch, as school lunches do not arrive until later in the morning.** The children will also need a sunhat, sun-cream and a lightweight coat in case of rain.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The coach will leave school promptly at 9.00am, so all children should arrive at school to be registered by 8.45am. We cannot wait for children who arrive late on the day. We expect to return to school by 4.30pm, depending on traffic, so please make arrangements to collect your child at this time outside Year 3 classrooms.

If your child suffers from travel sickness please ensure he/she has taken a tablet before coming to school. If another tablet is needed for the return journey, please send one in an envelope, clearly marked with instructions and the child's name.

**Please send £16.00\* in a named envelope to class by Thursday 14th June 2018.**
