ROOKERY FARM TRIP – RECEPTION CHILDREN – WEDNESDAY 18th JULY 2018

We will be taking the children to Rookery Farm in Stoke Bruerne on Wednesday 18th July. This is a farm that allows the children to look at and handle a variety of animals. The school are subsidising the trip, so the cost to parents is £10.00. This amount may be paid for through the Joinos online payment system. If you wish to pay by this method, please go to the School Office and ask for a Joinos code.

If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding, i.e. is eligible for the statutory benefit of a Free School Meal (*this is available to school-aged children from families who receive other qualifying benefits and who have been through the relevant registration process and is **NOT** the same as the Universal Infant Free School Meal to which all Reception and Key Stage One children are entitled*) or has been adopted from care, then the cost of this particular trip will be met through our Pupil Premium funding.

Your child will need a packed lunch on the day. Please avoid glass bottles and no fizzy drinks – thank you. Children who normally have a school lunch provided will need to bring their own lunch as we leave before they are delivered. They should wear their school tee shirt and jumper/cardigan with joggers or leggings and weather appropriate footwear. We will be outside all day, so a waterproof coat should be brought in case of rain. If the weather is hot please ensure your child has a hat, and that you apply sun block before they arrive at school.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please make sure they have taken a tablet before they come to school. If they will need another one for the return journey, please put it in a named, sealed envelope, and include clear instructions.
